TIMES AND ELIGIBILITY

TRIAL HOURS: 7:30 am until completion

ROLL CALL: AM Test – 8:30 am; PM Test – 1:00 pm

INSPECTION: Immediately follows Roll Calls with early Inspection available

ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY: Coursing Ability Tests are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program.

Dogs with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event.

EARLY ENTRY FEES AND PAYMENTS

MAIL ENTRIES to the Field Secretary's address above and make checks payable to "OCRRC". FAX ENTRIES will not be accepted. E-MAIL ENTRIES (jennifergysler@gmail.com) will be accepted provided the Field Secretary receives payment before 8:00 pm on Thursday, January 18, 2018 and the entry form is signed. If paying by Pay Pal, send fees to ocrrcdogs@gmail.com. Do NOT defer the fees to the club, or your entry will be rejected.

COURSING ABILITY TEST

Dogs run singularly. Veteran dogs are defined for this test as dogs older than 7 years of age. Veteran dogs may run two-thirds of the normal distance at the owner's discretion. A veteran dog's owner must declare prior to the start which distance the dog will run.

300 YARD COURSE: This distance is for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers and/or brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs. A veteran dog may run 200 yards at the owner's discretion. A dog must complete this course in less than 1 ½ minutes.

600 YARD COURSE: This distance is used for all dogs that do not run the 300 yard course. A veteran dog may run 400 yards at the owner's discretion. A dog must complete this course in less than 2 minutes.

RIBBONS AND TROPHIES

> Orange qualifying ribbons are awarded to dogs passing their test.

> Green and white rosettes are awarded to dogs earning the CA title.

> Purple, green, and hot green rosettes are awarded to dogs earning the CAA title.

> Achievement medals are awarded to dogs earning the CAX title.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. Dogs not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period.
2. Each entry will be examined at inspection for soundness.
3. Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused and have their entry fees refunded.
4. Spayed and neutered dogs may be entered.

OPERATIONAL INFORMATION

1. Gas powered continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lures will consist of plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available.

GENERAL INFORMATION

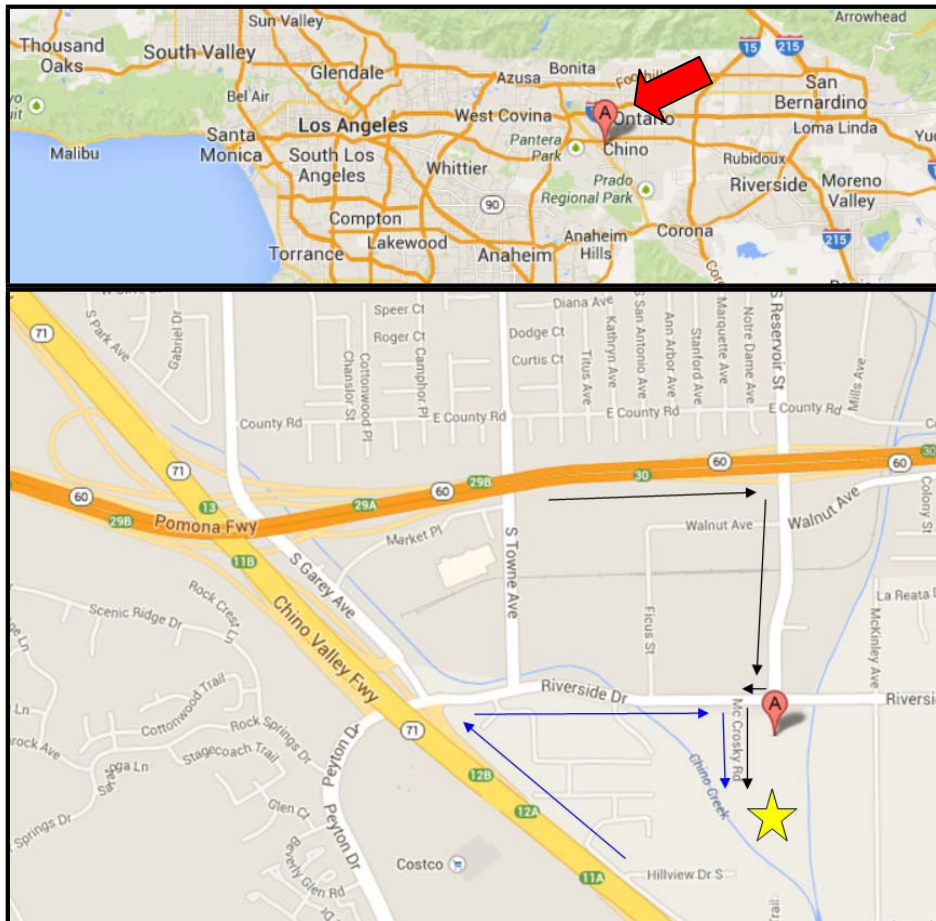
1. Please bring your own food, shade and water.

DIRECTIONS

From Orange County: Take the 57 North to the 60 East. Then, take the Reservoir Street exit. Turn right onto Reservoir Street. Turn right onto Riverside Drive and the facility will be located on the left side down McCrosky Road, a private dirt road.

From the Inland Empire: Take the 91 West onto the 71 North. Then, take the Riverside Drive exit. Turn right onto Riverside Drive and the facility will be located on the right side down McCrosky Road, a private dirt road.

From San Gabriel Valley: Take the 60 East. Then, take the Reservoir Street exit. Turn right onto Reservoir Street. Turn right onto Riverside Drive and the facility will be located on the left side down McCrosky Road, a private dirt road.

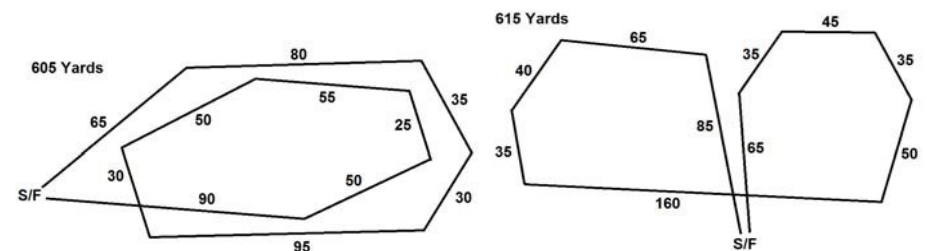
