WHAT BREEDS ARE ELIGIBLE?? This is a sighthound only event. Eligible breeds include: Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenji, Borzoi, Chart Polski, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Magyar Agars, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, and Silken Windhounds (UKC registration papers required)

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee for each hound will be \$10 if the entry form & fee (if mailed) are received at the Race Secretary's home by the end of Thursday, April 11, 2019. E-Mail Entries can be sent to skogsocigs@verizon.net e-mail entries must be received by 6pm on April 11, 2019. Fee will be paid for emailed entries on Saturday Morning.

Day of Entries will be accepted the morning of the meet, up until 30 minutes prior to roll call, day of entry fee is \$15 per hound.

IMPORTANT -- No exceptions will be made.

Early Entries and Fees are accepted by mail or may be emailed with signed entry forms and fees turned in on Saturday prior to the start of racing. PAYPAY IS NOT ACCEPTED.

The race meet secretary must still receive signed entry forms and fees at roll call for emailed entries. By entering the meet by email, you are agreeing to attend the meet and help with the running of the meet because we must be sure that enough people will be there in order to run a successful meet. By entering online, all owners and handlers shall hold harmless and defend from any claim for personal injury, illness or property damage arising out of participation in this race meet, Officers, Property Owners and Officials of the California Coursing Association and Members of the Large Gazehound Racing Associations. All Owners and Handlers agree to abide by the Official Rules of LGRA in effect at the time of this race meet.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Please be aware that everyone who enters a hound will be expected to help out with the running of the race meet. That would include duties such as walking the lure back to the start finish, line judging, foul judging, walking hounds to the box, and helping to retrieve hounds at the finish.

Parking

Irvine Regional Park charges a \$5.00 Entry fee. Exhibitor parking is available beside the barn in the large gravel parking lot. Parking in the drive way is for the field committee members and meet workers only.

NOTE:

Irvine Park in Orange, California is a 491-acre park with convenient parking and restroom facilities nearby. **PLEASE NOTE the park is not fully fenced.**

WHAT IS LGRA?

LGRA is sprint racing for GazeHounds. The hounds run 200 yards straight after a lure consisting of a fur, bag and squawker. Up to four hounds race a total of three times, called programs. Depending on the order of finish, they may attain national points towards a GRC, Gazehound Race Champion title. Irish Wolfhounds & Scottish Deerhounds will be hand slipped. All other breeds will be boxed, if a box is available and all entrants within a breed fit comfortably into the box (to be determined by the race committee). Hounds need to be one year of age or older to be entered. They will also need to be registered with LGRA. This can be done the morning of the race meet by bringing a photocopy of the hound's registration along with a \$2 fee & the completed LRN application. After registration, your hound will receive a LGRA number that will be used in entering future LGRA meets. 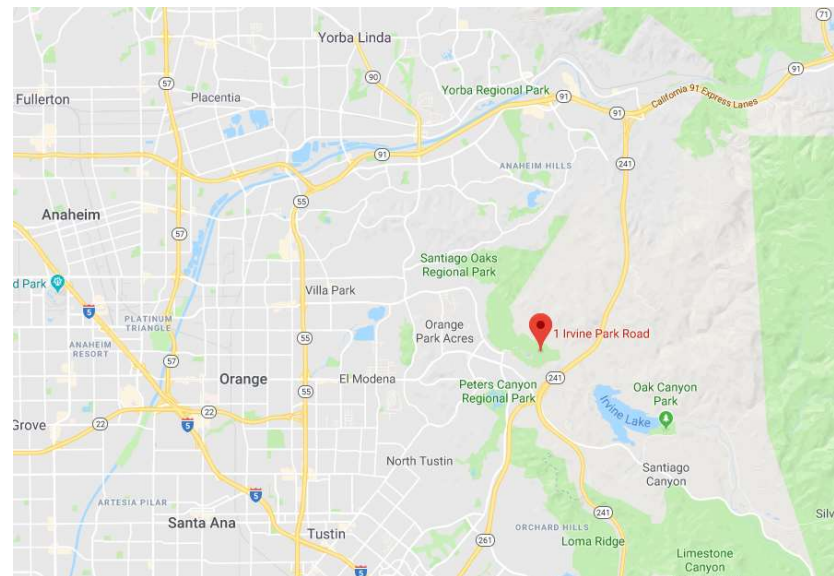

PARK ADMISSION FEES

General parking fees are \$5 per vehicle entry on Saturday and Sunday. There are no in-and-out privileges with this admission whereby leaving/returning to the park will require another admission.

Irvine Regional Park is at the far east end of Jamboree Road in the foothills of Orange. The nearest major cross streets are Chapman Avenue and Jamboree Road. Once you enter the park take the first left and park in Parking Area 2

FROM SOUTH ORANGE COUNTY/SAN DIEGO

Take the 5 North Exit at Jamboree Road Turn right and drive North Jamboree dead ends into Irvine Regional Park

FROM NORTH ORANGE COUNTY

Take the 22 East to the 55 North Exit at Chapman east then drive east on Chapman turn left on Jamboree Road and drive straight into Irvine Regional Park

FROM THE INLAND EMPIRE

Take 91 West and make the transition to the 55 South Exit at Katella Turn left and drive East Turn left on Jamboree Road and drive straight into Irvine Regional Park
