TIMES AND ELIGIBILITY

TRIAL HOURS: 7:30 am until completion

ROLL CALL: AM Test – 8:30 am to 9am; PM Test – 12:30pm to 1:00 pm

INSPECTION: Immediately follows Roll Calls with early Inspection available

ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY: Coursing Ability Tests are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. *Dogs with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event.*

EARLY ENTRY FEES AND PAYMENTS

MAIL ENTRIES to the Field Secretary's address above and make checks payable to "CCA". FAX ENTRIES will not be accepted. E-MAIL ENTRIES will be accepted provided the Field Secretary receives payment before 8:00 pm on Thursday, January 30, 2020 and the entry form is signed. If paying by PayPal, send payment to socalcoursing@gmail.com and pay for your own PayPal transaction fees. Do not defer the transaction fee to the host club or your entry will be declined. Fast CAT EVENT

Dogs run singularly in a timed 100-yard dash. The dog is released at the starting line by one person and must be caught by a second person at the finish line. These events are divided into 3 categories depending on the height of the dog. The height is used in the calculation with MPH to determine points awarded towards AKC FastCAT titles

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. Dogs not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period.
2. Each entry will be examined at inspection for soundness.
3. Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused and have their entry fees refunded.
4. Spayed and neutered dogs may be entered.

OPERATIONAL INFORMATION

1. Gas powered continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lures will consist of plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Please bring your own food, shade and water.
2. A restroom will be available.
3. No one, except Field Committee members, will be allowed on the field without the expressed permission of the Field Committee.
4. A \$5 fine will be assessed for loose dogs during courses in progress.
5. Anyone failing to clean up their dogs' waste will be excused from the field for the day.
6. Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be excused from the field for the day.
7. CCA assumes no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after the Tests and Trials.

POINTS CALCULATION

The dog's time to complete the 100 yd dash is converted into MPH. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

18" and over = 1.0 handicap

12" to under 18" = 1.5 handicap

Under 12" = 2.0 handicap

Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap

Fast CAT suffix titles are earned at designated milestones:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = every additional 500 points

DIRECTIONS

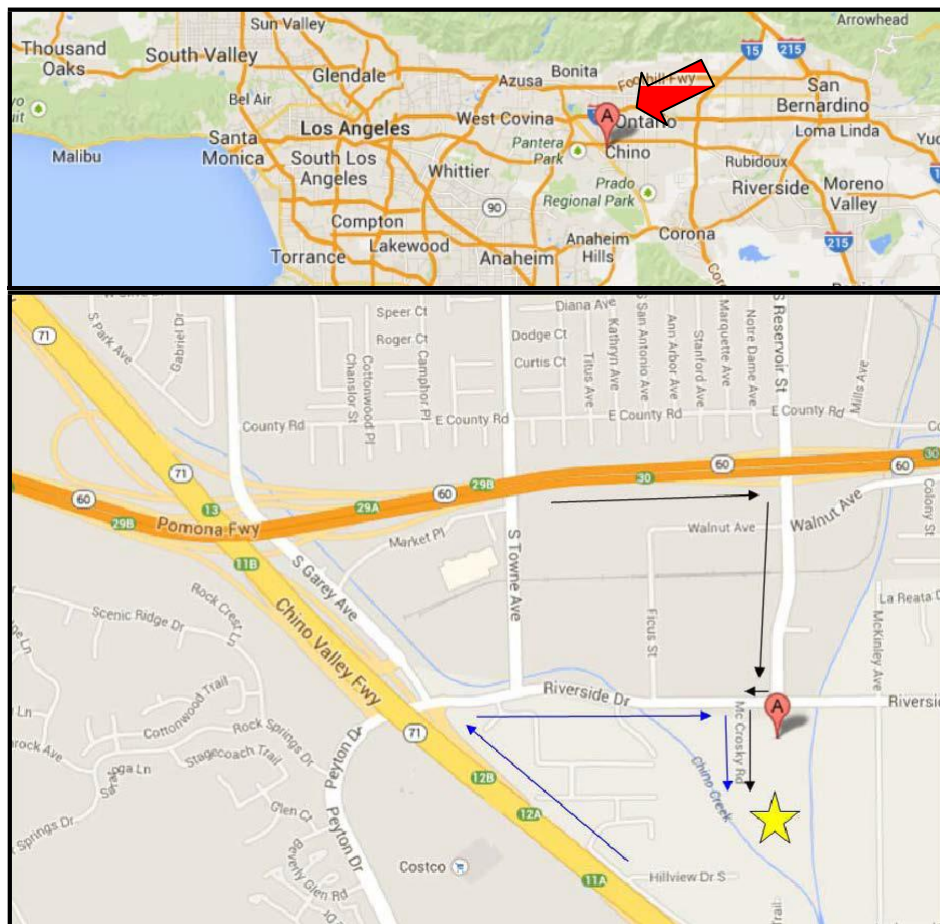
From Orange County: Take the 57 North to the 60 East. Then, take the Reservoir Street exit. Turn right onto Reservoir Street. Turn right onto Riverside Drive and the facility will be located on the left side down McCrosky Road, a private dirt road.

From the Inland Empire: Take the 91 West onto the 71 North. Then, take the Riverside Drive exit. Turn right onto Riverside Drive and the facility will be located on the right side down McCrosky Road, a private dirt road.

From San Gabriel Valley: Take the 60 East. Then, take the Reservoir Street exit. Turn right onto Reservoir Street. Turn right onto Riverside Drive and the facility will be

located on the left side down McCrosky Road, a private dirt road.

How Does a Fast CAT Work?

TESTS, TITLES & TIMING:

1. Fast CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards.
2. Dogs run singularly.
3. The dog's time to complete the 100 yd dash is converted into mph
4. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:
 - a. 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0
 - b. 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5
 - c. Below 12" = handicap is 2.0
5. Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap
6. Fast CAT suffix titles are earned at designated milestones:
 - a. BCAT = 150 points
 - b. DCAT = 500 points
 - c. FCAT = 1,000 points
 - d. FCAT# = every additional 500 points
7. Timing Devices: The time to complete the 100 yard dash is recorded to the nearest 1/100th of a second (e.g. 9.11). The Club uses break-the-beam equipment to obtain the time but may use stopwatches. If stopwatches are used, there shall be two timers positioned at the finish line. An individual at the start line shall signal with an arm drop the moment the nose of the dog crosses the start line. The timers shall start their stopwatches at the bottom of the arm drop. The timers shall stop their watches when the nose of the dog crosses the finish line. The times from the two stopwatches shall be averaged to determine the recorded time.

VOLUNTEERS WILL BE NEEDED FOR FAST CATS:

Please consider volunteering to release and/or catch dogs. Dogs will be released at the start line and collected at the finish line.

FAST CAT INSPECTION: All dogs will be inspected for soundness and measured prior to running each event. All bitches will be checked for being in season prior to running. [AKC Fast Cat Rules, Section 12]

RIBBONS: Participants will receive a light blue flat ribbon for crossing the finish line of this timed 100 yard dash.

THE START: Dogs may start up to 10 feet behind the starting line. [AKC Fast Cat Rules, Section 10(b).]

THE FINISH: It is recommended that the owner or someone familiar with the dog stand at the finish line in order to catch the dog once the course has been completed. [AKC Fast Cat Rules, Section 10(c).]
