CALIFORNIA COURSING

ELIGIBLE BREEDS

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs*, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Norrbottenspets*, Peruvian Inca Orchid*, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos*, Portuguese Podengo Pequenos, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis*, Thai Ridgebacks* and Whippets that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the American Kennel Club, the AKC Foundation Stock Service, an AKC recognized foreign registry or that have been granted an Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL/ILP) may be entered. FSS breeds are denoted with an asterisk.

LURE COURSING TEST

JC TEST RUNS: Open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound, at least 12 months of age, running alone shall receive a certification from a Judge on one date and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed a 600 yard course with a minimum of four (4) turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

QC TEST RUNS: Open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed or another breed with a similar running style (Partner Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge, stating that the hound completed a 600 yard course with a minimum of four (4) turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. **The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Partner Hound for the test. It is recommended that every Qualifying Hound practice with other hounds prior to being presented for a QC test.**

LURE COURSING TRIAL

OPEN STAKE: Open to hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser Certificate, an ASFA Field Champion title, or a CKC Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Champion title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

SPECIAL STAKE: Open to hounds that have earned their AKC Field Champion title.

OPEN VETERAN STAKE: Open to hounds that are eligible to enter the Open or Special Stakes and have reached 6 years of age on the day of the trial, except Irish Wolfhounds at 5 years of age, and Afghan Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis and Whippets at 7 years of age.

SINGLE STAKE: Open to hounds including those disqualified to run in other stakes.

Portuguese Podengo Pequenos, and FSS breeds are ineligible to compete for BIF.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period.
2. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications.
3. Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications (except for the Single Stake) and lame hounds will be excused and have their entry fees refunded.
4. Spayed and neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered.
5. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate.

OPERATIONAL INFORMATION

1. All hounds will run twice, in trios, if possible, or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
2. Each course will be reversed for the final runs while the Best of Breed and Best in Field running directions are determined by the judges.
3. Gas powered continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lures will consist of plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Please bring your own food, shade and water.
2. A restroom will be available.
3. No one, except Field Committee members, will be allowed on the field without the expressed permission of the Field Committee.
4. A \$5 fine will be assessed for loose hounds during courses in progress.
5. Anyone failing to clean up their dogs' waste will be excused from the field for the day.
6. Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be excused from the field for the day.
7. CCA assumes no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after the Tests and Trials.

SOCAL CUP QUALIFYING EVENTS

For any hound that enters these trials, they will accumulate SoCal points based on the number of dogs defeated within a particular sighthound breed. The dogs defeated are calculated on cumulative score without regard to the stake entered (i.e. open, special, veteran). Of the 14 scheduled trials, your hound must have minimally competed in 8 of them to attain eligibility into the SoCal Cup final in December.

From Orange County: Take the 55 North to the 91 East. Next, merge onto the 71 North. Then, take the Butterfield Ranch Road/Euclid Avenue (CA-83) exit. Turn right and the facility will be located on the right side 1/10 of a mile down Euclid Avenue.

From the Inland Empire: Take the 91 West onto the 71 North. Exit Butterfield Ranch Road/Euclid Avenue (CA-83) and make a right. The facility will be located on the right side 1/10 of a mile down Euclid Avenue.

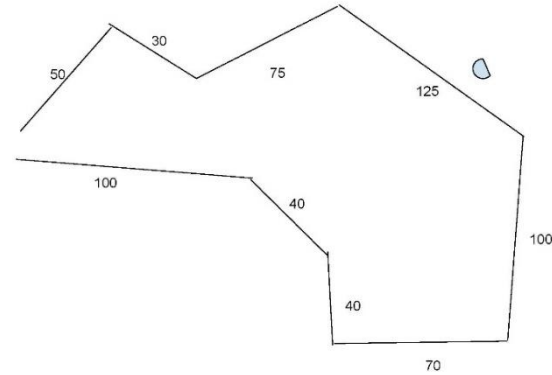

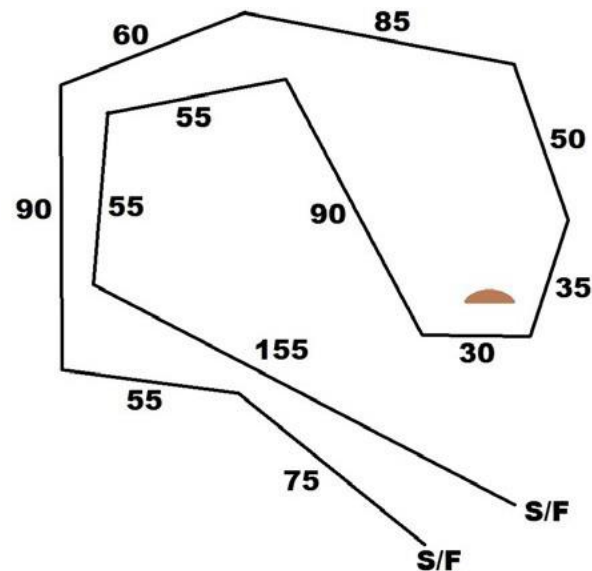

CALIFORNIA COURSING ASSOCIATION PROCEDURES

We will follow State and local guidelines.

1. All participant will wear facial coverings over nose and mouth and maintain social distancing of 6 feet.
2. Please bring your own food, water and shade for yourself and your dogs. None will be available at the trial.
3. We ask that you park 6 feet away from each other.
4. Roll Call will be done at everyone's car, instead of at the secretary's table area. The roll call committee will wear gloves and facial coverings. We will ask the owners of females to wipe their own dogs and show the inspection committee the tissue.
5. Wickets will be wiped down after each dog is measured.
6. We will have instant hand sanitizer and wet wipes in several locations for your use.
7. Huntmasters will stand 6 feet from the dogs after inspecting blankets and slip leads.
8. Dogs may be run in braces , at the discretion of the club, to ensure social distancing at the line and will be 6 feet apart.
9. Practice social distancing the best you can. Please act responsibly.
10. We will be posting the draws and scores for each breed separately to allow for ease of social distancing, and will post them on the So Cal Coursing FB page.
